The single estate belongs to his family since the 17th century.



Whether top of the range, high priced and produced in restricted quantities or in mass volumes designed to meet the needs of the major international markets, the demand for quality in the final product never wavers whatever the circumstances.

JOSÉ NEIVA CORREIA – The scientist



Quinta da Ponte

Mr. Neiva does a pioneering role in several areas like the introduction in Portugal of the varietals Caladoc (50% of the ALTA CORTE) and Dornfelder.

Furthermore, he has developed and patented a method for disinfecting the corks using ozone that has since been sold onto Grupo Amorim. This has helped worldwide in reducing the level of undesirable **TCA** (the Trichloroanisol compound causing the "musty smell"), a great threat to wine making.





JOSÉ NEIVA CORREIA - RESPECTING THE ENVIRONEMENT



Single estate Portela

Mr. Neiva promotes strongly healthy agricultural practices in the 200 ha of his family vineyards the vines are fed with organic material.

The nutrition of the vines is done in a rational way without excesses or deficiencies. The vine's needs dictate the dosage of water and nutrients conceded.

The final result is high quality production, something we feel well when tasting the **GRAND'ARTE** Shiraz.


The multifaceted terroir of the Lisbon wine region





DFJ VINHOS company born in 1998 reached an average annual production level of six million bottles, exporting more than 97%, across 33 brands and 77 different wines deriving from all mainland Portuguese regions, from the Douro, Lisbon, Tejo, Setúbal and Alentejo, producing wines with Portuguese and international grapes, in pursuit of the client's pleasure to more than 45 countries.





DFJ VINHOS born from the will of three men; Dino (D); Fausto (F) and José (J).

Since 2005 DFJ Vinhos belongs only to José Neiva Correia which it's also the chief winemaker.

DFJ born in 1998 only to export to the UK.

José Neiva Correia has been the first winemaker to create Portuguese wines following the taste of the UK consumers.





DFJ headquarters are located in the **Quinta de Fonte Bela**. A centuries-old single estate, almost all
the buildings respect the "Cast-iron Arquitecture" of the
late XIX century, used by Eiffel's followers.

Named in the region the **Wine Cathedral** host a vinification center, bottling line, warehouse, wine cellar with 7,4 million liter capacity, barrel cellar, cooperage facilities, laboratory and guests room.




The House of Storks



This "Grand'Arte" pay tribute to the wine, one of the main elements of the Portuguese Gastronomy.




CERTIFICATION OF THE QUALITY BRC – GRADE A
